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Research question

Objective

- To systematize the state of knowledge regarding information literacy instruction




Methods

- Systematic literature review
 - selection of studies available on the Internet
 - a survey was performed, both in Portuguese and English
 - EBSCO HOST, B-on and RCAAP
- Conducted during the first quarter of 2013


Methods

- Boolean search for:




Results

- EBSCO-Host Portal: **846** articles matching



Results

- B-on Portal: **45,000** references





- RCAAP Portal: **154** references



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Selectivity criteria

- Simultaneous matching of a set of conditions:
 - a specific subject (user education in information literacy);
 - the type of study and methodology (case study analysis of a reality by observation, survey, interviews, etc.),
 - participants (users, readers, students),
 - and context (university library).



State of the art: recommendations




- To insist on knowledge, on the part of students, of existing resources.
- To develop and affirm the intrinsic value of libraries for the personal and professional development of its users.
- To better communicate with target audiences.

State of the art: recommendations

- To actively disseminate training.
- To understand the multiplying effect of training.
- To affirm librarians as promoters of educational success.
- To integrate the content of training in information literacy in the curriculum.

Information Skills

- Exceptions:
 - Nova University of Lisbon (Faculty of Science and Technology Library)
 - University of Lisbon (library of the Faculty of Psychology and Institute of Education),
- Their training activities are described as including ideas related to structuring a scientific work, to registering information and to writing strategies.

Conclusions

- Role of librarians in higher education in Portugal
 - investigations and studies still incipient
- Training in information literacy – information scarce
- Suggestion - Creation of working groups, with common aims and activities, in order to strengthen information literacy in Portugal.
